You are required to promptly notify us of the occurrence of any changes which may affect your certification.

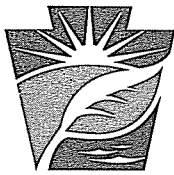

Only the certified individual and the employees that are DEP-listed may perform radon testing in Pennsylvania.

We have adopted the U.S. Internal Revenue Service definition of employee, which is the common law definition. Therefore, in order to satisfy the conditions of certification, persons who perform the firm's radon activities over which the certified individual is in responsible charge must be actual employees of the firm, rather than independent contractors. We reserve the right to require proof of employment at any time.

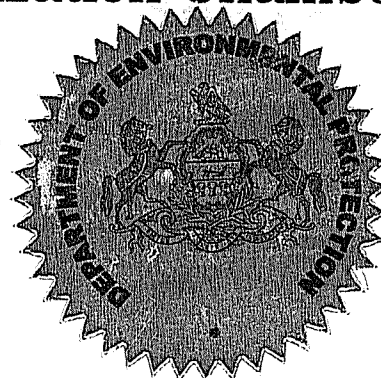

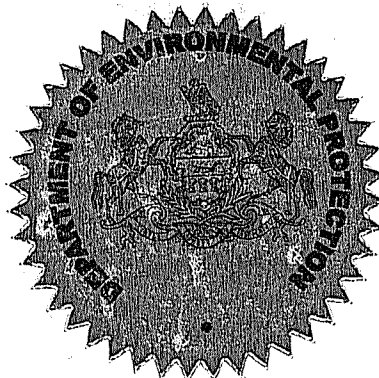
